Drive to Playa Giron, where the Bay of Pigs Invasion took place. You have the option to stop for a brief swim once you close to the area.

Visit the modest Bay of Pigs museum, which gives you an inside look into how the Cuban government portrays this historical milestone.

Visit the Bay of Pigs Museum at Playa Girón

Visit the beach where the Bay of Pigs invasion occurred, as well as the Museo de Playa Girón, located a stone's throw away from Playa Girón, one of the beaches invaded during the Bay of Pigs.

Museo Girón houses photographs, exhibits and artifacts related to an infamous, failed American-backed invasion of Cuba in 1961. Cuba's victory over the US, on the other hand, helped solidify the Revolutionary government just two years into its existence.

The items inside the small building detail the history what some call the first defeat of US imperialism in Latin America, and evidence that the Cuban Revolutionary government was here to stay.

Tanks and aircrafts used in the Bay of Pigs invasion are on display outside the museum.

Stop in Cienfuegos to Visit the Main Square, Galeria Santa Isabel. and the Palacio del Valle

Stop in Cienfuegos to see the main square, the town's most reputable art gallery (Santa Isabel), and Palacio de Valle, where you can enjoy a drink on the rooftop bar.

This is where the three valleys (San Luis, Santa Rosa, and Meyer) interconnect. The area was once a major center for sugar production, especially from the late-18th century until the late 19th century. The first stop will be at San Asidro de los Destiladeros, one of the most important cites related to the sugar industry. The second stop will be in Manaca/Iznaga, where the largest sugar factory during the 19th century was located. The final stop will be at El Mirador del Valle to enjoy a view if valley and Guamuaya mountains.
